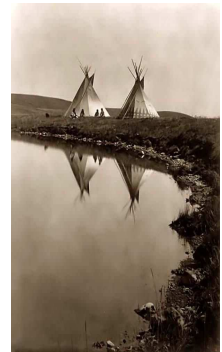

*With Doug Woodrow*



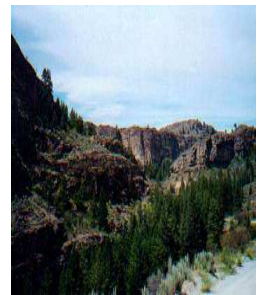
Join Doug for a discussion on the life and work of famed photographer Frank S. Matura. Matura documented much of the early history of the Okanogan with vivid photography.
